We compete against the other 8 other Brookline area schools, including the other K-8 public schools.

What is Math League?

Math League is a highly competitive math olympiad held between 9 Brookline area schools and the kids will be competing for team trophies in five categories: Operations, Bases, Geometry, Patterns and/or Problem Solving, depending upon where they are assigned. Who?

Math league content is essentially sixth grade challenge math and an enrichment activity aimed at mathletes craving challenge beyond what they are currently learning. It is not a remedial activity. We work hard, we have fun, we help each other and we never ever give up. We expect to be stumped, but we also expect to push through and persevere. Only fifth and sixth graders can compete (district policy) but fourth graders should train with the team so they can excel next year and hit the ground running.
